It is one of the most advanced European countries in combating these bad practices.

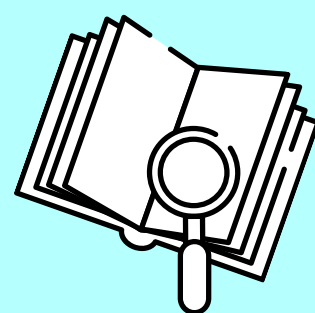

Wiki dedicated to cases of plagiarism



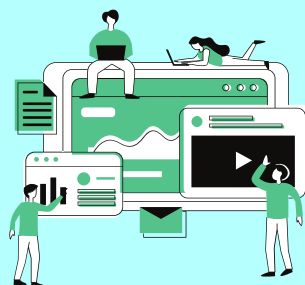
Ombudsman
