INTRODUCTION



Wikipedia has been used in a significant number of educational practices and its use has become a common training activity in recent years in all educational environments, thanks to its large readership and to being an open knowledge website where readers can contribute to the construction of multiple topics.

The wikipedia research was carried out at two different institutions: the Universitat Pompeu Fabra (UPF) in Barcelona (Spain) and the University of Niš (UN) in Niš (Serbia).

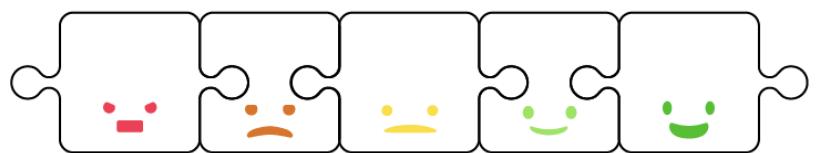

CONCLUSIONS

Editing and creating articles on Wikipedia generally had a significant influence on students' perception of Wikipedia, in terms of reliability, on the platform.

Students had already anticipated that editing Wikipedia articles would be interesting and challenging, and these perceptions increased after the experience.

Their appreciation of the task of editing articles, which was valued as interesting and challenging, also changed. students' appreciation and valuation of Wikipedia's social prestige, both in the university and general context, did not change significantly.
